

Rules and Guidelines for LLOYD SAUNDERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

To be qualified to apply, Applicant must satisfy the following:

1. Applicant must have successfully participated in and completed the Washington County Fair Calf Scramble Program.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in a college, trade school or other institution of higher education ("College").
3. Applicant must have completed and passed at least 12 hours of courses at Applicant's College after graduation from high school. Courses taken in high school ("dual credit" courses) will not satisfy this requirement.
4. Applicant must be in academic good standing in Applicant's College.
5. Applicant must be a US citizen.

Together with the Application form, Applicant must deliver the following (all in one envelope, please):

1. A transcript from Applicant's College showing that Applicant has passed 12 hours of courses at Applicant's College (not "dual credit" courses).
2. Evidence from Applicant's College that Applicant is presently enrolled and in good standing at Applicant's College and there is no bar against Applicant's further study there.
3. An essay describing why Applicant deserves a scholarship. The essay should be no less than one and no more than two pages.
4. Two letters of recommendation.
5. A recent photograph.

Applications and the items listed above must be turned in to Kenny Lucherk no later than September 10, 2020.

If Applicant is selected for a scholarship, funds will be paid directly to Applicant's College.
